

SIDE COVER MOD

Issue:

The question is often asked: “are the side covers interchangeable between 1100 Custom and Classic?”

The short answer is yes, and no.

The left hand covers, with the lock, are interchangeable.

The right hand Classic cover bolts at the front and the Custom at the top.

The frame on the Classic has two mounting points on the right hand side. A front one that will attach the stock cover and a top one that will attach the Custom cover.

In order for the right hand Classic cover to fit the Custom, a simple mod is required.

Modification:

On the Custom, it is a simple matter of relocating the top-mounting nut from the frame, to a position that will accept the front mounting bolt position. This can be achieved by using a 2 to 2-1/2 inch aluminum conduit strap. Remove the speed nut from the frame, and bolt one end of the strap to that hole.

Bend the strap around until it is in position to line up with the front hole on the Classic cover. This may take a few tries but will not be too tough to accomplish. Once that's done, affix the speed nut to the end of the strap and attach the cover.
